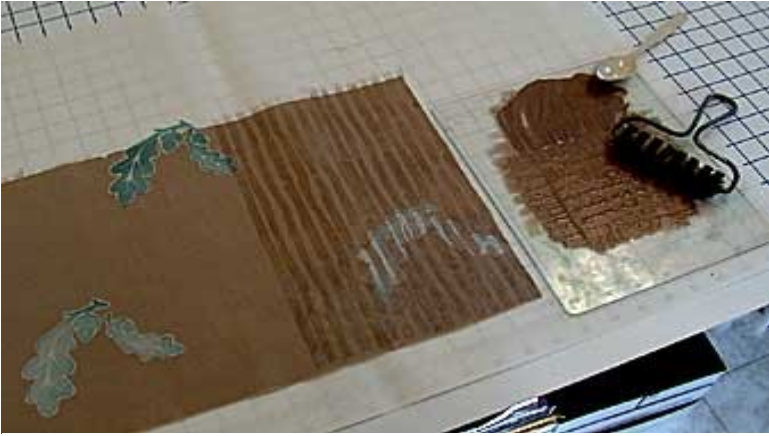


Calamari roller



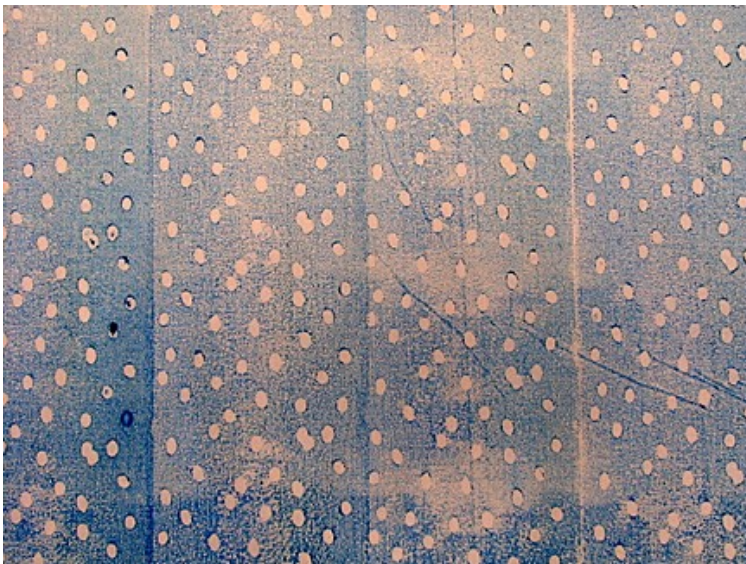
I created a textured stripe with a foam brayer that has been altered. To make the nifty brayer, I simply slid the foam tube off the roller, cut it in to rings, and slid some of the pieces back on. Cutting the foam with scissors gave me some interesting and uneven rings!

You can slide the "rings" in different configurations for a variety of effects!

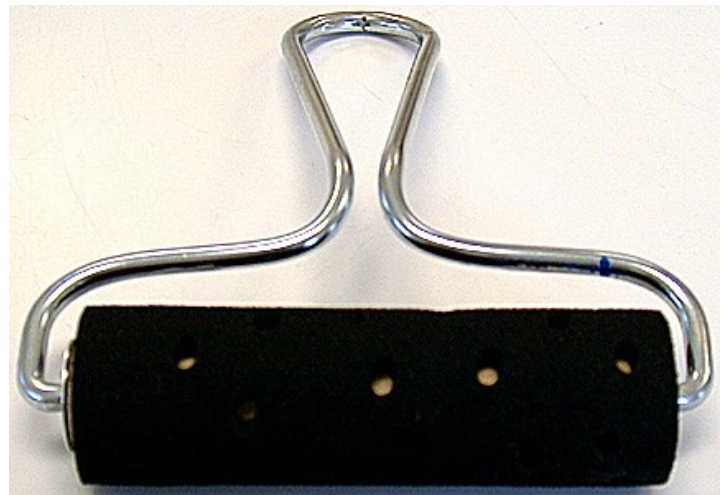


Detail of the "calamari" roller.

SWISS CHEESE ROLLER



Texture is created with a foam roller that has had "holes" punched in it. To punch the holes use a "leather punch" as it has a wider opening and can cut through the thick foam with ease. **TheSewingPlace.com** carry these, or a friend who has horses may have one you can borrow!

By alternating the leading edge of the foam roller you can achieve a checkerboard effect (the paint applies heavier on the leading edge).
